Minutes:

Minutes for the December 14th Meeting have been approved.

- New Focus Area Document:
 - o Focus areas have been tweaked a little.
 - This document will be published if no edits need to be made.

- Civil Lawyer Outreach

- The civil rights attorney reached out and was upset that the coalition existed and thought it was against the law.
- We can't ignore the fact that the supreme court decision has brought up a lot of different opinions in the public.
- The coalition is doing great work and there is no need to be worried about these opinions.
- No one is being excluded but we are focused.
- Judge Mares will be doing a CLE in Seatle for the National Hispanic Bar Association to discuss these issues. If you would like more information contact Judge Mares.

Focus Area Updates:

- Focus Group 1: Encourage Diverse Lawyers to Apply for Judicial Vacancies and Help Prepare Interested Applicants
 - Membership Programs.
 - The Dream Team Program was a CLI program that helped coach diverse candidates. There was a one-hour video for judges to train the difference of mentoring vs coaching.
 - An email will go out for all the sitting judges to ask for volunteers to mentor/coach.
 - Waiting for Justice Marquize's approval.
 - A letter will be sent out to give people in the community an update about the coalition.
- o Focus Group 2: Support the Retention of Diverse Judicial Officers
 - Been reaching out to diverse judges around the state to find unique issues that diverse judicial offers face and what the coalition can do to assist them.
 - Spoke to Justice Marquez and Kent Wagner about this.

- Everyone was interested in having focus groups from judicial officers to understand what needed work.
- Focus groups will be conducted. An email will be sent out to explain the focus group. The focus group will be completely confidential.
- Develop a list of volunteers to send the email out to.
- The app is called Meatometer. It allows a host to ask questions and receive responses that every participant will see but it will not be connected to a particular participant.
- Working on spotlighting Diverse Judicial Officers. If you have any thoughts reach out to the Co-chairs.

 - Thrive
- Courageous conversations came up with the judges and might be a good way to tie it in to this group.
- Focus Group 3: Be a Resource for Key Decision-Makers
 - They had two focus groups, and the turnout was great.
 - Two pages of questions.
 - The highlight of the focus groups is that they needed more education and resources, especially for the non–lawyers.
 - No uniformity on unsolicited information.
 - Sometimes a great candidate will be selected and sent to the governor, but the governor does not select them. The commissioners would like more information on why.
 - The commissioners felt like there were no issues with lack of representation.
 - A report will be put together and brought back to the commission.
 - It might be useful to share with other Commissioners to allow them to add things.
 - Commissioners are willing to be part of a buddy system to discuss things.
- o Focus Group 4: Be Visible
 - Judge Mares and Judge Braswell have been continually active in the community and have been invited to CU Bolder to talk about the coalition.
 - Judge Mares is also sitting on a panel.
 - Everyone should be sharing the coalitions work in the community. We need more people power.

- Every Focus group should have one meeting between now and the next Coalition meeting.
- Budget:
 - Is there anything that the Collation will need a budget for?
