Eighth Judicial District Court judge finalists selected Governor to appoint new district court judge

The Eighth Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for a district court judgeship created by the retirement of the Hon. Julie Kunce Field, effective Oct. 8, 2021. Nominees Cara Boxberger of Severance, Joseph Findley of Loveland, and Matthew Zehe of Fort Collins were selected by the commission on Aug. 27, 2021.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from Aug. 30, 2021, within which to appoint one of the nominees as district court judge for the Eighth Judicial District (Jackson and Larimer counties).
