Adams County Court judge finalists selected *Governor to appoint new county court judge*

The Seventeenth Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for a Adams County court judgeship created by the retirement of the Hon. Michael A. Cox, effective July 2, 2021. Nominees Courtney Dinnel of Arvada, Phelicia Kossie-Butler of Aurora, and Trevor Moritzky of Broomfield were selected in a meeting via videoconference on June 7, 2021.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from June 8, 2021, within which to appoint one of the nominees as county court judge for Adams County.
