This year, we pose the following questions/prompts:



Middle School Contest (6th-8th grade students)

The U.S. Constitution was written to unite the country after it had many different ideas and challenges. Drawing on your personal experiences, explain how the Constitution brings people together and helps people with different opinions work together. *500 words*

High School Contest (9th-12th grade students)



The phrase "Out of Many, One" reflects the idea that despite the United States' cultural, geographical, and political diversity, there is still a unified American identity. Drawing on your personal experiences, explore how the Constitution has shaped your perspective on what it means to be an American.
