Petition for Writ of Certiorari GRANTED. EN BANC.

[REFRAMED] Whether a decedent's legal files are property within the meaning of section 15-12-709, C.R.S. (2019).

[REFRAMED] Whether a decedent's personal representative becomes the holder of the decedent's attorney-client privilege upon the decedent-client's death.

[REFRAMED] Whether the Rules of Professional Conduct permit a lawyer to reveal information relating to the representation of a deceased client to the decedent-client's personal representative.

[REFRAMED] Whether the court of appeals erred in holding that the personal representative had a right to the decedent's legal files.
